**Title:** Upgrade deletes userdefined importrelation records

**Description:** From 6.1 we no longer delete the importobject and importfield records belonging to userdefined tables (see id 3090). We do unfortunately still delete the importrelation record, so if this returns any results:  
select \* from crm5.importrelation where foreignkey in (select dbfieldid from crm5.importfield where tag like 'undef%') on the database before upgrade, make sure you have a backup of these records so you may insert them again.  
From 6.1 we now make sure to delete only our standard fields, so if you look at the I\_ImportLocaleText.imp table found in SuperOffice\init of a 6.1 installation you will see that we have added the "truncate\_field tag XXX" for all our built in fields on ImportObject and ImportField. We need to do something similar with importrelation, however, here the source or target if pointing to a builtin record must be updated with the new importobject\_id.

**Title:** Problem when trying to open archived e-mails twice

**Description:** SuperOffice SIX.One [v6.1.01.540]  
Windows Server 2003 Standard Edition R2  
Happens on all pc's with Office 2007 installed.  
We have a problem with a customer who is on SIX.One with Office 2007. When any user tries to open an archived email in SuperOffice they can access it without a problem. If you close the email and then try to access the same archived SuperOffice email you get the 'cannot open file' error which usually means that the file is already open either on their PC or another person has opened it on another PC. When we check the 'Open Files' view on the server you are able to see that the file that was opened is still saying open by the first user. The locked file then clears but takes up to 5mins to clear. During which time users cannot access this email.

cw: Old Contact Search bug (i.m.o) - There are a number of issues in Contact Search that we have kept postponing.

What happens here is:

- SSelectionMemberData(SHDatabase& i\_HDb, SContactItem\* i\_pItem) is called.

There is a discrepancy in i\_pItem between its numReturnFields member (16) and its value array which is set up with a maximum of 15 items.

Eventually, item no 15 is retrieved which will index outside the array of SvStr.

Using this base I was also able to reproduce this using our main.unicode branch.

These issues have normally had to do with the number, type and order of the criteria.

What we have here is:

**Description:**

- 1) Generate a new 6.1 database
- 2) Add a few resources to the Resource list
- 3) Start SuperOffice, create an activity and invite a customer and a resource
- 4) Save the activity and refresh with F5

Observe the wrong activity is displayed in the archive. The ID column has the resource as the owner and not the associate. It doesn't matter if you are on SQL 2000 or 2005 and it seems to be a problem only in 6.1, not in 6.0.

The consequence is the activity shown in the archive is not editable and it is not possible to complete it.

Another symptom is if you delete the activity, only one record is deleted and after you refresh the activity is there again, but with a different contact. It depends on how many people / resources you invite. It is very nicely visible if you disable the invitation filtering.

Expected: the correct activity with the associate as the owner is displayed in the Activities

NB: A customer with 130 users with the database upgraded from 5 to 6 and to 6.1 has highlighted the problem. I can't replicate the problem on an existing database but the same is happening on a new database.

Attached a testdatabase, username/password = aa/  
Observe that the activityarchive looks ok until you refresh it.

3.) Now you change to your calendar and tick on "finished" Checkbox for one of your To Do's. You see that SuperOffice hangs up (at our customer the user who did this blocks EVERY other user).

When you change to another customer and not into your calendar everything is fine.

2 - fields are not replicated correctly when updated centrally, have updated both small and large for all entities (except project) in this dwn file and they are not read into the travel database correctly. Some are missing all together, and appointment/document just overwrite the current record (as expected since there is no preference to set field level replication for appointment and documents  
(I expect project to behave the same way since all other enabled field level replications do)
